COMMUNITY IMPACT

CARE Fair

(Community Assistance and Resource Event)



Junior League CARE Fair, which celebrated its 17th year in August 2009, is an annual two-day event for families needing routine medical services and community assistance information. The League has served over 50,000 clients since the project's inception. In 2009, Junior League of Salt Lake City helped 4,500 individuals with:

- 221 immunizations
- 389 eye exams
- 330 dental screenings
- 162 women's exams
- 90 pediatric orthopedic exams

Women Helping Women

The Women Helping Women Clothing Boutique is a Junior League of Salt Lake City project in which volunteers collect, prepare, and distribute donated professional clothing to women entering the workforce who are in transition to self-sufficiency. Women Helping Women has served nearly 10,000 women since it began in 1996 and has distributed more than 11,000 articles of clothing and personal items in 2009 alone.

Mini Projects

The League provides volunteers and funding to short-term, typically "done-in-a-day" projects in collaboration with other nonprofit organizations. Our Mini Projects program has served more than 80 organizations since 1990.

RISE

(Refugee Integration into Society through Education)

In collaboration with Catholic Community Services, the League created the RISE course to teach refugee women, and thus their families, the basic knowledge and necessary skills to become self-sustaining members of our society. The course focused on three major areas: health/wellness, hygiene/cleanliness, and budget/finance.

Kids in the Kitchen

Over the past three years, the League has worked with more than 1,500 Title I students in the Salt Lake Valley. This project fights the national trend of childhood obesity by providing lessons and demonstrations in the preparation of healthy meals and snacks and empowering youth to make healthy lifestyle choices.
