CARE Fair

Established in 1992, CARE Fair has served more than 73,000 people in Utah. The annual two-day event provides families with routine medical, dental, and vision services along with community assistance information. These medical services are provided free of charge at the Junior League of Salt Lake City CARE Fair.

Women Helping Women

Since 1996, the Women Helping Women clothing boutique has provided professional clothing to help women in need re-enter the workforce. Since it was established, more than 243,000 articles of clothing have been donated by the community and more than 20,000 women have been helped.

Mini projects are typically done-in-a-day events that involve short term volunteer support from JLSLC members. These projects provide members with the opportunity to interact with and support other non-profits in the community.
